



Dream On Scholarship



Jack was known for pioneering research in tree fruit production and serving on the Wenatchee School Board and the North Central Regional Library Board. WVC's first vocational science building is named in his honor. Irene taught high school students in Wenatchee and East Wenatchee and held leadership positions with the local PEO. Scholarships are awarded to students in the tree fruit program.

Robert and Mary Jean Carter established this fund in 2001 in memory of the couple who befriended them in 1968 when they first moved to Wenatchee. Jay Eller was an early physics and math instructor at WVC.

Richard Lapo grew up during the Depression and post WWII era, but due to the generosity of others he was able to attend Westminster Choir College in Princeton New Jersey where he received both his Bachelor and Master of Music degrees. After working some years full-time in church music, he moved his wife and family to Wenatchee in 1967 and he taught, directed, performed and mentored in the Wenatchee Valley College Music, Arts and Drama Department until his retirement in 1994. He believed in the value of education and often used his allotted choir scholarship fund (and sometimes the cash from his wallet) to help WVC students remain in school. 
