Pay tuition by the tuition deadline. Chapter 31 (Voc Rehab) and Chapter 33 (Post 9/11) recipient are not required to pay tuition by the tuition deadline. Chapter 30 (MGIB) and other VA education benefit recipients must pay tuition by the tuition deadline or have other funding such as financial aid.
